**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, AMENDING THE  
CITY’S CODES OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 10, ALCOHOLIC  
BEVERAGES, TO PROVIDE AMENDMENTS TO LICENSES FOR  
CERTAIN BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS**

**ARTICLE ONE**

Section 10-48 (b) (5) of the City’s Code of Ordinances is hereby amended in part by adding the double underlined (double underlined) language as follows:

*(5) As used herein, "event center" shall mean a rental space for group functions such as, but not limited to, wedding parties, conferences and conventions, service club meetings, and similar gatherings, along with the catering of food and/or alcoholic beverages. A licensed event center located within a designated Entertainment District shall be permitted to sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption to the public, but shall derive no more than 20% of total annual gross sales from the sale of such alcoholic beverages.*

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Council of the City of Fayetteville, Georgia do hereby adopt the attached City of Fayetteville Ordinance.
