**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, AMENDING THE CITY'S CODES OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 10, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, TO PROVIDE AMENDMENTS TO QUALIFICATIONS FOR ISSUANCE OF LICENSES FOR CERTAIN BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS.**

**THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE  
HEREBY ORDAINS THAT:**

**ARTICLE ONE**

Section 10-48 (b)(1)c of the City's Code of Ordinances is hereby amended in part by adding the double underlined (double underlined) language as follows:

*c. Bowling centers, billiard centers, gaming centers, golf clubs, performing arts theaters, or movie theaters serving the general public and which derive no more than 25 percent of their gross sales from sale of malt beverages and wine, only. Businesses described in this subsection 10-48(b)(1)c. may not be licensed to serve distilled spirits. The licensee must comply with all prescribed safety standards set forth in city ordinances and state laws and regulations.*

**ARTICLE TWO**

Section 10-48 (b) of the City's Code of Ordinances is hereby amended in part by adding the double underlined (double underlined) language as follows:

*(9) As used herein, "performing arts theaters" shall mean a multi-use performance space that is intended for use by various types of live performing arts, including dance, music, and drama. The maximum seating capacity shall not exceed 1,000 seats for a performing arts theater.*
