Application for **RECYCLE BIN & REFUSE DUMPSTER ENCLOSURES Permit** Fee: **\$100.00**

Notice: Recycle bins and refuse dumpsters are subject to provisions of the City Ordinance - Article II. Collection and Disposal.

Submit on 8 1/2" x 11" size paper or larger, a drawing of the recycle bin enclosure or refuse dumpster enclosure, description of the materials and colors that will be used, and calculations of sizing and construction details. Submit a site plan including all structures, driveways, streets, right-of-ways, property lines, existing and proposed enclosure location, and other significant site features, as needed to review application. (Enclosures should be located on rear of property or adjacent to building. Enclosure materials and colors should be compatible with building.)

City of Fayetteville Code of Ordinance

ARTICLE II. COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL

Definitions from Section 70-1

Dumpster, recyclable means a receptacle, designed for the depositing of recyclable material, made of any material and having a capacity of two cubic yards or more.

Dumpster, refuse means a receptacle designed for the depositing of garbage, refuse, trash, ashes or reusable materials, made of any material and having a capacity of two cubic yards or more.

Sec. 70-32. Pickup hours regulated.

It shall be unlawful for any commercial garbage service to pick up trash containers, dumpsters, or other such containers between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., except in the case of a bona fide emergency, the nature of which has been communicated to the city manager of the City of Fayetteville at the time of said emergency. Sec. 70-39. Screening of dumpsters.

Business, commercial, educational, and other nonresidential buildings and any multifamily residential building for which the use of a commercial or multi-user dumpster has been authorized by the City of Fayetteville shall screen any portion of a dumpster which is visible to an average person from a public street, parking lot, or residential building, which is within 300 feet of such dumpster. Said screening shall be constructed of building or fencing materials that are of sufficient opacity to conceal the dumpster from view. Evergreen shrubs, or evergreen trees may be used for screening of public-use, recyclable dumpsters placed by governmental entities or nonprofit organizations recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as exempt from federal income taxation, when a plan for such screening has been approved in writing by the city manager or his designee. Individual lots zoned M-1 or M-2 are exempt from the screening requirements, if the properties on each side and in front or across the street from the front of said lots are also zoned M-1 or M-2.

Sec. 94-209. Other requirements.

(a) All trash receptacles, dumpsters, ductwork, fixed operating machinery, and other such utility equipment shall be screened so as not to be seen (except for the screening) by a person standing within 100 feet of the structure or building and shall be located not less than ten feet from side and rear property lines.
